

Booking ahead by telephone for all trips is always advisable to avoid disappointment, we can also advise you about the trip. To reserve your place, call on **01263 740 753** between 8am-6pm (7 days a week). No payment for advance bookings is required until you collect your ticket. If you need to transfer or cancel a booking, please give at least one hours notice.

Tickets must be collected from **BLAKENEY QUAY** no later than 30 minutes before sailing time. (Please allow for Norfolk roads!) We operate in all weathers as long as it is safe to do so. Warm or waterproof clothing is advisable, but we have waterproof plastic macs available for £1 for unexpected showers. You can bring a dog, (at our discretion) but please keep it on a lead.

For that special occasion, why not charter one of our boats for a private trip. Charters are available for all of our boats for up to 100+ people at special rates. (Discounts are also available for groups of 12 or more for scheduled trips when booked in advance). **BISHOP'S BOATS** have been running seal watching trips departing from the picturesque Blakeney harbour since early 1965.

This family run business has two traditional purpose built clinker construction wooden boats and one smaller boat.

Our boats wind their way down the creek before heading out into sheltered waters and onto the far end of Blakeney Point. Without going out into the open sea, our experienced skipper's take you to known areas frequented by seals. However, we ask



that you appreciate that we do not control, or attempt to influence their natural behaviour or



habitat in order to see them (see our guarantee\*). The best vantage point for the seal colony is from the boats, which are able to get close to the

basking seals near the water's edge without causing any disturbance. Here you may observe both common and grey seals. Our knowledgeable crew will tell you about the wildlife on Blakeney Point. There are many species of birds to be seen too, including a large tern colony well established on the reserve. All trips are seal-watching trips lasting approximately 1hr. As we do not land on Blakeney Point we are able to spend a little longer at the seal and tern colony.
